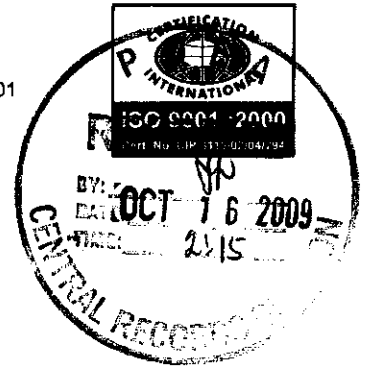




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MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 15

TO : ALL CONCERNED

SUBJECT : SELECTIVE DEPLOYMENT TO NIGERIA FOR WORKERS-ON-LEAVE (WOL)
/ BALIK-MANGGAGAWA (BM)

Pursuant to Governing Board Resolution No. 08, Series of 2009, providing for the partial lifting of the ban on deployment of overseas Filipino workers to Nigeria and allowing the processing and deployment of workers-on-leave/balik-manggagawa bound for the country, the following guidelines are hereby issued:

1. Coverage. The partial lifting of the ban on deployment of landbased Filipino workers to Nigeria shall cover OFWs presently employed in Nigeria and are coming home for vacation/leave;
2. Documentary Requirements. The following documents shall be submitted to the POEA for processing of the WOL/BM.
 - a. Proof of employment with the same employer such as valid employment contract, employment certificate or similar document
 - b. Valid return visa to Nigeria
 - c. Valid passport
3. Period of Effectivity of the Selective Deployment to Nigeria

The selective deployment of workers-on-leave/balik-manggagawa to Nigeria shall remain in effect unless sooner withdrawn or otherwise directed.

This Memorandum Circular shall become effective fifteen (15) days from the date of publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
