SINGAPORES' DISEMBARKATION PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS FOR SEAFARERS

The Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) has provided this Administration with the procedures and requirements of Singapore's Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) for seafarers disembarking in the city state.

According to Singapore's ICA, foreign seafarers who wish to sign off from a vessel in Singapore are required to liaise with the local shipping agent for assistance to submit the signing off application to ICA. Once the sign off application is approved, the local shipping agent will be issued with the approved sign off letter. The seafarers are required to proceed to Marina South Pier/West Coast Pier or any of the designated Ports Command Gates to obtain a Special Pass before reporting to the checkpoint for departure.
