**TO : ALL CONCERNED**

**SUBJECT : Monitoring and Reporting on the Employment Status of Filipino Workers On-site and Manpower Demand from Employers from the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) States**

Further to POEA Advisory No. 02, series of 2016, on the subject **Monitoring and Reporting on the Status of Filipino Workers in Workers in the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (KSA), Iran and Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) States**, requiring concerned agencies which have deployed workers to the above-mentioned countries and other GCC countries to report on the inventory and status of their deployed workers affected by the KSA-Iran situation, agencies are also requested to monitor the situation of workers who may likely be affected by the current oil price decline. Reports shall include the following information:

- a. retrenchment involving their deployed workers
- b. pre-termination of employment contracts resulting to worker repatriation
- c. requests for deferred deployment from employers
- d. suspended job orders
- e. other information deemed relevant to the subject

Agencies are requested to coordinate with their respective employers to closely and regularly monitor the employment status of their deployed workers, worker outflow/deployment, and movement of job orders from employers. Reports shall be submitted to the POEA Pre-Employment Service Office at [marketing\\_poea@yahoo.com.ph](mailto:marketing_poea@yahoo.com.ph), every Thursday of the week or immediately as may be necessary.
