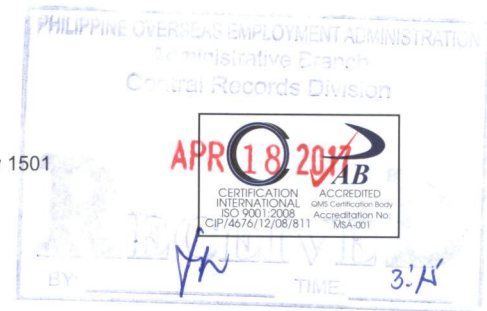

To : All POEA-Licensed Landbased and Seabased Agencies  
Subject : Suspension of Medical Facilities by the Department of Health

The Department of Health has suspended the operation of eight (8) Medical Facilities for Overseas Workers and Seafarers pending investigation on the alleged monopoly being practice by them in the conduct of pre-employment medical examination for migrant workers bound for Kuwait. The suspended medical facilities are as follows:

1. **ABAKKUS MEDICAL DIAGNOSTIC SERVICES** – Lot 22 Blk. 38 Calatagan Street, Brgy. Palanan, Makati City;
2. **AGONCILLO MEDICAL CLINIC** – Ground Floor and 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, 1721 Building, F. Agoncillo Street, Malate, Manila;
3. **RUBEN C. BARTOLOME, M.D. CLINIC, INC.** – Bartolome Tower, 878 Nakpil Street, Malate Manila;
4. **GLOBAL MEDICAL CLINIC, INC.** – 1800 A. Mabini Street, Malate, Manila;
5. **ORION MEDICAL AND DIAGNOSTIC CENTER** – 1956 P. Hidalgo Street, Malate, Manila
6. **OUR HEALTH MEDICAL AND DIAGNOSTIC CENTER** – 801 D. United Nations Avenue, Barangay 666, Manila;
7. **OUR LADY OF ALL NATIONS X-RAY, LABORATORY, MEDICAL AND DENTAL CLINIC** – 463 Remedios Street, Malate , Manila; and
8. **SAN MARCELINO MEDICAL CLINIC** – 2118 Leon Guinto Street, Malate. Manila.

As such, all landbased and seabased agencies are advised to refrain from sending workers to the above-mentioned Medical Facilities until their suspension is lifted by the Department of Health.
