



AUTOMOBILE PROJECTS IN ABU DHABI TO MAKE UAE THE REGION'S FIRST AUTOMOTIVE HUB

The Philippine Overseas Labor Office (POLO) in Abu Dhabi has reported that two private sector projects worth a total of Dh8.84 billion will build an off-shore automotive and tourism complex, the region's first automobile hub.

The first project, the \$2 billion (Dh 34 billion) AutoPolis, will be built on an island near Abu Dhabi AutoPolis. It will house a major regional distribution center for car manufacturers and dealers. It will also offer amenities for tourists, including a museum, hotel, auto-related shops, an exhibition and convention center, a theme park and villa.

The second project, the DH1.5 billion Autohub will be set at Mussafah Industrial City. It will cluster automotive operators, distributors, manufacturers and auto-related industries.
